BEFORE

Pull Away

Have everyone place phones and devices in another location so you can be present together

Pray

As a group, ask God to prepare your heart to hear God through His Word and through time together in worship

Read

As a group, consider reading Psalm 9:1–2 before the service starts

Listen

- Have your Bibles with you and gather elements for communion.
- Access the Worship Service: citizenschurch.com

DURING

- Sing together. This could feel awkward at first, but recall that you are singing together to our God. Our singing brings joy and allows us to interact with the God of all creation (Psalm 89:1, Psalm 132:9, Colossians 3:16).
- Read together with the teacher.
- Take communion together
- Embrace the obstacles and challenges that come along with church at home. God is with you even in the distractions and hurdles.

AFTER

- Pray and thank God for the gift of being with other believers in worship.
- Consider, talking through what you heard and how God spoke to you through the service.
- Make sure to help clean up at the end. This is a way of loving and showing respect for your hosts.
